THE WEST KOWLOON CULTURAL DISTRICT AUTHORITY

The West Kowloon Cultural District (WKCD) is to be developed as an integrated arts and cultural district with world-class arts and cultural facilities, distinguished talents, iconic architectures and quality programmes with a must-visit appeal to both the locals and tourists on a harbourfront site of 40 hectares in Hong Kong. The core arts and cultural facilities in the WKCD will comprise 15 performing arts venues, a museum called M+, an exhibition centre and piazza areas.

The WKCD Authority (the Authority) was established in 2008 for the planning, development and operation of the WKCD, and is governed by a Board which is also the executive body of the Authority. Headed by the Chief Executive Officer (CEO), the Authority comprises 7 departments - Project Delivery Department, Museum Policy & Management Services Department, Performing Arts Policy & Management Services Department, Marketing, Communications & Programming Department, Finance Department, Human Resources Department and Legal Department; and an Internal Audit. On 4 July 2008, the Finance Committee of the Legislative Council of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region approved an upfront endowment of HK\$21.6 billion to the Authority for developing the WKCD. The Authority is now recruiting a **Senior Planner**, two **Senior Architects**, a **Senior Civil Engineer**, a **Senior Traffic and Transport Engineer** and a **Senior Environmental Engineer** in the Project Delivery Department. The Project Delivery Department is headed by the Project Delivery Executive Director.

SENIOR PLANNER (Ref: Planner)

The Position Reporting to the Design, Planning and Destination Development Manager, the Senior Planner is responsible for managing and monitoring the conduct of consultancy studies; facilitating and contributing to the preparation of the Conceptual Plan Options and Development Plan, and facilitating the submission of the Development Plan to Town Planning Board.

The Candidate The candidate should possess at least 10 years of post-qualification experience in planning for major development projects, or equivalent. He/She should have knowledge in master planning studies and planning applications and related submissions to the Town Planning Board.

SENIOR ARCHITECT (Ref: Architect)

The Position Reporting to the Design, Planning and Destination Development Manager, the Senior Architect is responsible for managing and monitoring the conduct of consultancy studies; facilitating and contributing to the preparation of the Conceptual Plan Options and Development Plan; and Schedules of Accommodation and Functional Briefs for Core Arts and Cultural Facilities; and providing technical support to the Major Works & Retail, Dining and Entertainment / Commercial Contract Management Team.

The Candidate The candidate should possess at least 10 years of post-qualification experience in architecture projects, or equivalent. He/She should have knowledge in master planning and design of arts/cultural facilities.

SENIOR CIVIL ENGINEER (Ref: Civil Engineering)

The Position Reporting to the Technical Services Manager, the Senior Civil Engineer is responsible for managing and monitoring the conduct of consultancy studies; and facilitating and contributing to the preparation of the Conceptual Plan Options and Development Plan as well as the associated technical assessments and engineering design; and providing technical support to the Major Works & Retail, Dining and Entertainment / Commercial Contract Management Team.

The Candidate The candidate should possess at least 10 years of post-qualification experience in major civil engineering projects, or equivalent. He/She should have knowledge in civil engineering studies.

SENIOR TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT ENGINEER (Ref: Traffic)

The Position Reporting to the Technical Services Manager, the Senior Traffic and Transport Engineer is responsible for managing and monitoring the conduct of consultancy studies; and facilitating and contributing to the preparation of the Conceptual Plan Options and Development Plan as well as the associated technical assessments and engineering design; and providing technical support to the Major Works & Retail, Dining and Entertainment / Commercial Contract Management Team.

The Candidate The candidate should possess at least 10 years of post-qualification experience in major transport planning and traffic studies/projects, or equivalent. He/She should have knowledge in traffic and transport modeling, traffic impact assessments, traffic and transport planning studies, parking studies and marine transport studies.

SENIOR ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEER (Ref: Environmental)

The Position Reporting to the Technical Services Manager, the Senior Environmental Engineer is responsible for managing and monitoring the conduct of consultancy studies; and facilitating and contributing to the preparation of the Conceptual Plan Options and Development Plan as well as the associated technical assessments and engineering design; and providing technical support to the Major Works & Retail, Dining and Entertainment / Commercial Contract Management Team.

The Candidate The candidate should possess at least 10 years of post-qualification experience in environmental studies, or equivalent. He/She should have knowledge in environmental impact assessments, sustainability assessments and air ventilation assessments.

The candidates should possess a membership of an appropriate professional institution or equivalent. For **Senior Architect**, the candidates should be an Authorised Person registered in Hong Kong.
